



Online Masterclass with Dr Jonathan Hardy 'Heaviness, Collapse and Disintegration: Plutonium, Positronium and Related Remedies' Saturday 26 June 2021, 10 - 4.30 pm

In this webinar we will see a number of cases of **Positronium**, **Plutonium** and related remedies including **Radium bromatum**, **Uranium nitricum** and **Helium**. We will study the themes of Row 7 and of Row 1. Row 7 has the feeling of such heavy responsibility that there is a feeling of needing to be superhuman or to divide oneself into multiple personalities in order to cope. In the extreme there is a sensation of disintegration and decay. There can be an intense desire to let go of the heavy pressure and burden. Positronium -antimatter - is a remarkable remedy with a distinct feeling of extreme weight, heaviness and collapse. The cases we will see demonstrate the remarkable sensation of stone-like heaviness, compression and division into two parts. Helium, being in Row 1 has a reluctance to even begin the process of incarnation. Nevertheless we will see cases showing it can also be a remedy for people with heavy responsibility. Their coping mechanism is a different kind of withdrawal.
